

The Ragdoll stays kitten like into adulthood and old age. They enjoy a game of fetch or can even be taught to walk on a leash. Ragdolls are slow in maturing and don't reach their full size until around 4 years. Ragdolls are suited to any home; they do well with children, and other pets.
